Farewelling Year 6

End of year activities for the current Year 6 cohort have also commenced with this week holding the Year 6 Farewell last Wednesday at Waitara Magpies, Surf Lifesaving excursion a couple of weeks ago and in Week 10, Monday will be the Celebration of Learning assembly and Thursday will be the Mini Fete. On Friday 16 December the 'Walk through the Arch' will be the final event and Year 6 parents are most welcome to come onsite for that.

Leadership Year 5

During this term, Year 5 have been preparing for their transition into Year 6, when they will become the senior students at the school. This is a position of great privilege and responsibility as Year 6 students serve as role models for all the younger students. 21 Year 5 students have run for senior leadership positions of school captain, vice captain and SRC executives and yesterday 2023 leadership elections were held. Each candidate wrote and delivered a speech to their fellow students from Years 3-6, after which student voting was carried out via an online form. Whilst we consider all Year 6 students at Waitara to lead by example, some students have been elected by their peers to fulfil senior student leadership positions. Today the staff will also cast their votes and the final outcome will be determined ready to be shared at the Year 5 Celebration of Learning Assembly next week. There will also be a formal Induction Assembly for the 2023 Student Leadership team early in Term 1 next year.

Staff Leaving in 2022

We have several staff leaving us for promotions and permanent positions. Ms Kate Noble is taking up a position of AP at Forest Lodge PS, Mrs Kim Fisher is taking a position of AP C&I at Dural PS, Ms Lis Green, Mrs Talia Drivas, Ms Danielle Tonkiss will be taking up permanent teaching positions. Mr Giuffre is moving to a temporary position at St Ives HS as a PD/H/PE teacher for 12 months.

Mrs Suzanne Daykin is retiring after 30 years at the school.

Mrs Jenny Naylor is also retiring. She has been an OC Teacher for 10 years.

Class Formation 2023

Our anticipated enrolment next year in approximately 1030 and we plan on forming 40 classes. However, this is dependent on possible new enrolments and students leaving which is constantly changing. Students will return in holding classes and we will form classes as soon as we can firm up our enrolment numbers.

School Development Days

This year the last day of school for students will be Friday 16 December. There will be a Staff Development Days for teachers at school on Monday 19 and Tuesday 20 December. However, teachers and administration staff will not be on site on 20 December as we are conducting an off-site professional learning day in the city. Next year at the beginning of 2023 we will have two Staff Development Days 27 & 30 January. Students in years 1-6 will start on Tuesday 31 January. Our Kindergarten students begin on Friday 3 February after their Best Start testing.

Results for the NAPLAN and Check in Assessments

We have been analysing our NAPLAN and Check in Assessments for 2022 and on the whole, we are pleased with our results. We are consistently above state average in Year 3 and Year 5 in both Literacy and

Numeracy and above similar schools grouping for Literacy and Numeracy in Year 5. This data will drive curriculum areas next year.

We would like to thank the P&C for their work this year, Jack for your leadership and ongoing support of the school and all committees and office bearers. You are such an essential part of our school community and it is always a privilege to attend these meetings in my executive role.

6. General Business

- **Uniform survey results** SF shared the results gathered from the survey:
 - o 200 respondents (189 parents, 7 students, 1 community member, 1 staff, 2 blank)
 - 95% responded that they were satisfied with the options provided for the school's SUMMER uniform.
 - 90% responded that they are satisfied with the options provided for the school's WINTER
 - Some of the feedback we have received:
 - Functional, doesn't need ironing, works well. Nothing to change. It isn't broken so don't fix it. Just allow some leniency for the first few weeks of change over terms (ie if it is too cold at beginning of term 4 for shorts, let them wear pants, and if it is too warm for pants in term 2 let them wear shorts)
 - Expensive
 - Shorts as an option for girls in summer is an improvement. The less ironing required over all uniform items the better.
 - Having a single uniform all year round is really helpful for families of children with sensory processing disorders

The overall results of the survey have been good and we thanked the community for their participation.
